Text of email to follow shortly

“UK Athletics is introducing an individual registration scheme from this year onwards to cover club members who wish to take part in open road and cross country races. The individual UKA registration fee per member prior to 31 March 2008 will be £3 which Hardley Runners will cover for this year only.

We will soon need to make a submission to UKA to register those runners who intend to run in any UKA open road or cross country race before 31 March 08.

Members who participate only in the RR10 and CC6 series will not need to be UKA registered. The requirement to affiliate is only applicable to UKA permitted events and there are already some events run under ARC permits which do not need this requirement (see ARC website – link on Links page).

Please indicate by a return e-mail whether you and any other family member will be competing in open races prior to 31 March 2008 under Hardley Runners membership so that we can apply for individual registration on your behalf.

Nil response will mean that you would NOT be UKA registered and you would need to pay the £2 'unaffiliated' levy should you decide to enter any UKA permitted open event.

From April 08 the individual UKA registration fee will increase to £5 or more. It is therefore likely that our club will need to consider a two tier membership option from next year with an appropriate uplift in the subscription fee for those members requiring UKA registration.

We look forward to an early response so that we can submit this year's registration application.”
